

Kokomo and Howard County intend to develop a plan that identifies opportunities to reduce injury and fatalities in three significant areas:

- Structural Identify intersections and roadway segments with the highest number of injuries and fatalities and determine improvement options that will reduce accidents. The community also intends to increase the use of low-cost, high-impact strategies to improve safety over a wide geographical area.
- 2. Systemic Develop procedures and criteria for implementing speed reduction and traffic calming improvements, providing consistent and defensible regulatory traffic ordinances, and identify locations and times for enforcement, all to reduce injuries and fatalities.
- 3. Development Standards Update standards for new development and redevelopment that will reduce speed and congestions, as well as the need for private automobile trips.

These three areas will be addressed not just with respect to automobiles, but all forms of transportations, including pedestrians, bicyclist, public transportation users, and micro-mobility users and commercial operators.

The community intends to monitor accidents across the county to identify positive and negative trends as they relate to recent improvements. The community expects to develop tools to effectively collect and track the extensive data available, which includes not just accidents, but traffic volumes and violations, to proactively address negative trends as they are identified.

Kokomo and Howard County will focus on addressing equity by comparing areas within under-served census tracts with other areas of the city, as well as concentrating on underserved users, typically those not utilizing automobiles as well as non-English speaking persons, throughout the community.

The community intends to complete this plan within one year of a signed agreement. Furthermore, the city intends to continue collecting and assessing data under this plan for two years after the completion of the plan, to ensure implementation and evaluate the effectiveness of strategies and projects.


